- Organized 8-19 July 1916 at Douglas, Arizona
- (35th Infantry assigned 7 August 1918 to the 18th Division; relieved 14 February 1919 from assistance to the 18th Division; assigned 17 October 1922 to the Hawaiian Division; relieved 1 October 1941 from assignment to the Hawaiian Division and assigned to the 25th Infantry Division)
- Relieved 1 February 1957 from assignment to the 25th Infantry Division and reorganized as a parent regiment under the Combat Arms Regimental System (CARS)
- Assigned 19 February 1962 to the 25th Infantry Division and activated at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)
- Withdrawn 16 August 1995 from the Combat Arms Regimental System and reorganized as a parent regiment under the United States Army Regimental System
