Summary: At 1240 hours Oxide Quake (Baron Teets CO SF Camp Plei Mrong) reported contact at grid coordinate ZA 096718. They received automatic small arms fire and 60mm Mortar fire. Friendly casualties were none. The size of the enemy force is also unknown. The radio was recovered by a patrol at 0735 hours 8 September 1968. The radio was found to be totally destroyed. The frequency had been changed prior to destroying the radio.
