

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Operation Situation Report Number 70-67 (U)

Period covered 101800H March to 111800H March 1967

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1. (C) General: 2d Battalion, 35th Infantry Task Force continued to conduct search and destroy, ambush and blocking actions as a part of the 1st Brigade, 4th Infantry Division portion of Operation SAM HOUSTON. Battery C, 2/9 Artillery and a squad from Company 1, 4th Engineer Battalion remain attached to the 2/35 Infantry Task Force.

a. A/2/35 Infantry continued the mission of security of the Task Force firebase located vicinity YA677534, conducting local patrolling and ambushes from the beginning of the reporting period until 110800H March, when the company initiated movement to the south toward YA658480, closing vicinity that location at 111645H March. During the move south the company discovered an old NVA position located vicinity YA 677520, containing 25 bunkers, of which 2 had overhead cover, an NVA raincoat, and a metal container for a CHICOM and a 60mm mortar round. The ammunition container and the raincoat will be evacuated for intelligence value; the other items were destroyed in place. No resupply was effected in the night location, in order to maintain the security of the night position.

b. B/2/35 Infantry continued to conduct search and destroy operations on their assigned axis of advance, departing their night location vicinity YA673560 at 110815H March, and closing at the Task Force firebase vicinity YA677534 at 111205H March without incident. On closure, Company B assumed the mission of security of the firebase and conducted patrols and ambushes in the vicinity of the position.

c. C/2/35 Infantry was closed at the night defensive position vicinity YA696560 at the beginning of the reporting period. At 102030H March the company observed several small fires resembling NVA cooking fires at YA723556, at a range of approximately 2500 meters. Artillery was placed on the target with 35 rounds of 155mm and 112 rounds of 105mm howitzer, resulting in 10-15 secondary explosions and numerous indications of small arms ammunition being detonated by fire. An air strike was requested on the target, but was not delivered due to higher priority targets. The time-distance factor precluded a follow-up sweep of the target area by ground elements. At 110810H March, Company C departed their night location, and continued their search and destroy operation toward the south. At 111230H March, Company C discovered a battalion size base comm vicinity YA685561, composed of 150 bunkers all having overhead cover, with 8' connecting tunnels. Also located two mess halls in area. An additional 400 rounds of C4 were air dropped to C Company to permit complete demolition of the bunker complex prior to departure from the area. The company closed the night defensive position at check point 15, vicinity YA666548 at 111800H March without further incident.

e. Reconnaissance Platoon 2/35 Infantry remained attached to Company A until 110800H March, when Company A departed from the Task Force firebase. At 111205H March Company B closed the firebase, and the Reconnaissance Platoon was attached to Company B. A five man element of the platoon remained as a battalion observation post and security for an BRU element located vicinity YA696560. A four man IRRP (LRRP) 152 Golf designation) was inserted vicinity YA705600 at 111700H March to provide surveillance of an area of probable enemy activity, and to conduct an IZ reconnaissance for a combat assault planned for 13 March. A five man LRRP from the 3rd Brigade, 25th Infantry Division was attached at 111000H March, for operations as directed by Task Force Headquarters.

f. The Heavy Mortar Platoon 2/35 continued to support all elements of the Task Force by fire.

g. Engineer Squad, Company A, 4th Engineers, attached as the "Cacti Blue Engineers" continued improvement of the firebase, destroying trees on approaches to the helicopter landing pads.

h. General Concept of operations: TF 2/35 Infantry closed two rifle companies conducting search and destroy operations from north to south, one to assume security of the firebase, the other to establish a defensive position nearby to act as reserve reaction force to company deployed in vicinity of B52 strike. The third company moved south to the area of a B-52 strike conducted at 110830H March as follow-up on the B-52 strike, and to conduct search and destroy operations on known areas of enemy border infiltration.

2. (C) Plans Summary:

a. A/2/35 will continue a thorough sweep of the area of the B-52 strike, bounded by YA648479, YA673495, YA680480, YA655488. Resupply operations will be conducted at 121200H March at an IZ to be selected, and a stay-behind IRRP (52 HOTEL) will be inserted at that time; subsequently Company A will continue movement toward the north to a night location vicinity YA6750. There will be no resupply at this location. On 13 March, Company A will close on the Task Force firebase, and will assume responsibility for the security of the Task Force firebase.

b. B/2/35 will continue as security for the Task Force firebase vicinity YA676535 until 131230H March, when the company will be prepared for movement as the follow-up company for a combat assault to be conducted at 131330H March, vicinity YA705600, and subsequent search and destroy operations west for 4000 meters, and thereafter south to the Task Force firebase, closing by 151200H March. Company B will conduct local retrolling and ambushes in the vicinity of the firebase until relieved of firebase security.

c. C/2/35 will conduct local retrolling, security, and ambushes in the vicinity of the present company location, and will be prepared to conduct a combat assault on an IZ located vicinity YA705600 at 131330H March. The IZ is now under surveillance by IRRP "52 GOLF". Thereafter, Company C will

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Search and destroy operation 4000 meters to the west, and then
to the Task Force firebase, closing at 151200H March.

d. Reconnaissance Platoon 2/35 Infantry remains attached to Company B until 131230H March, passing to attachment to Company A when that element assumes security of the Task Force firebase. Personnel on the OP located vicinity YA695560 will be rotated periodically. LRRP team (LRRP) 52 GOLF remains under battalion control vicinity YA705600. LRRP team (LRRP) 52 HOTEL will be inserted as a stay-behind force with Company A at 121200H March, and will pass to battalion control at that time. Reconnaissance Platoon will be prepared to provide the attached five-man LRRP for possible employment vicinity YA7153 of YA7155 for surveillance.

e. C/2/9 Artillery will continue to provide fire support to all elements of the Task Force and all other friendly elements on request.

f. Heavy Mortar Platoon 2/35 Infantry will continue to provide fire support to all elements of the Task Force and all other friendly elements on request.

g. Engineer Squad, Company A, 4th Engineer Battalion will continue improvement of approaches to helicopter landing areas, provide engineer support to rifle companies on request, and prepare to support destruction of positions in the present firebase when friendly forces are withdrawn.

h. General Concept of Future Operations: Company A will complete surveillance of the B-52 strike area, conduct search and destroy operations on an axis from that area to the firebase, and will return to the Task Force firebase as a security element at 131200H March. Company C, followed by Company B will conduct a combat assault on an LZ vicinity YA705600 at 131330H March, thereafter sweeping two companies abreast for 4000 meters to the west, thereafter turning south and continuing the search and destroy operation south to the Task Force firebase.

3. (C) Major Unit Operations: Battalion Task Force continued participation in operation SAM HOUSTON.

4. (C) Small Unit Operations:

a. Total by Types: Three company size search and destroy missions, one squad size patrol, and two squad size ambushes were conducted. One LRRP was inserted during the reporting period.

b. Enemy losses: None confirmed.

c. Friendly losses: None

5. (C) Civic Action: There are no friendly Vietnamese located within the area of operations.

6. (C) Psychological Operations: Leaflet drop, requested on 4 March was conducted on 10 March in the area bounded by YA758600 - YA770600 - YA750580 - YA770580. Leaflets were targeted on NVA personnel. Delivery was too late for effective use, as US elements departed the area on 9 March.

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e. (C) General:

a. Personnel strengths remained critical. Percentages present for duty vs authorized strengths were as follows:

3. SUMMARY OF EN ACTIVITY

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A. GROUND ACTIVITY

(1) (LATE ENTRY) Co A, 101500H, vic YA674536, loc co size en camp containing waist deep foxholes, sleeping platforms, cooking fire pits and mess hall. Est to be approx 30-45 days old. Camp was not destroyed.

(2) Co C, 101940H, vic YA713566 obs 1 light. Arty fired in area. Sweeps produced neg results.

(3) Co C, 102031H, vic YA723556 obs numerous ground fires. One fire flared up and was quickly extinguished. Arty fired in area resulting in 10-15 secondary explosions (HE type) and undetermined amount of SA fire either fired or detonated by burning fire.

(4) Co A, 111052H, vic YA673520 loc co size bunker complex - 25 bunkers chest deep. 2 bunkers had o/h cover. Est 2-3 weeks old. Also disc at same loc 1 empty CHICOM 60mm mortar case and en raincoat. Bunkers not destroyed, mortar case and raincoat destroyed.

(5) Co C, 111146H, vic YA685563 loc I (3-4 men) hooch est 2 days old. Size: 9x6. Hooch destroyed.

(6) Co C, 111230H, vic YA685561 loc bn size bunker complex. Bunkers had o/h cover w/connecting tunnels (8 ft tunnels), 2 mess halls. Est 7-10 mos old. Est 1st used 6 mos ago. 8 bunker complex (OP) oriented NW and main bunker complex oriented in 360 deg circle. Bunkers were not destroyed.





1. Enemy

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a. Summary of enemy activity:

- (1) 181600, Co A, vic YA691601, observed one NVA approximately 400M NW of LZ. Co A to check area out.
- (2) 190905, Co A, vic YA692597, located two enemy bunkers, one had overhead cover, one without. Estimate one month old. At same location discovered OP position for 3-4 men. Estimated last used 2-3 days ago. All destroyed.
- (3) 191000, Co 1, vicinity YA 689595 located 2 enemy bunkers 1 had overhead cover, 1 without overhead cover, estimated 1 week old. size: 2-3 man bunkers. Bunkers were destroyed.
- (4) 191025, Co 1, vicinity YA689595 located 5 (5 man) bunkers. 3 with overhead cover and 2 without overhead cover, 1 cooking pit. 2 trails - 1 West - East, 1 West - South. Estimated 1-2 weeks old. All were destroyed.

b. Personnel and Equipment Losses.

- (1) Personnel: Negative
- (2) Equipment: Bunkers Destroyed - 9.

c. Weather and Terrain Conditions: No change.

d. Enemy capabilities and vulnerabilities:

- (1) Enemy remains capable of attacking in force and conducting large scale mortar attacks on friendly positions as well as mining of and maintaining surveillance of the road from 3T to the FSB.
- (2) Enemy remains vulnerable to air strikes, artillery fire, and ambushes on known and used trails.

e. Conclusions:

- (1) Enemy is still maintaining surveillance of and conducting reconnaissance of the FSB.

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(2) Enemy continues to avoid contact.

2. Own Situation

a. Operation Summary: 2d Battalion 35th Infantry Task Force continued to conduct search and destroy, ambush and blocking actions as a part of the 1st Brigade, 4th Infantry Division Operation SAGE HOUSTON. Battery C, 2d Battalion 7th Artillery and one squad from Company 1, 4th Engineer Battalion remain attached to 2d Battalion 35th Infantry.

- (1) A/2-35 conducted a heliborne assault at 191500 Mar 67 into LZ, YN 670603. They then started a sweep to night location YN 600602. At 191030, three television cameramen from Spain were inserted into Company 1's location. They were later extracted and the company continued to sweep west.
- (2) B/2-35 continued to provide FSB security by local patrols during the day and ambush positions at night.
- (3) C/2-35 conducted an airmobile assault with A/2-35 into LZ, YN 670603, and maneuvered, to the night location with A/2-35, YN 600602. At 190745 Mar 67, C/2-35 started its sweep to the west.
- (4) Recon/2-35 continued to provide LRRP support and reinforcement to the FSB perimeter. In addition, one squad conducted a night ambush patrol to the northwest along a north-south trail network located 400 meters to the north of the FSB.

b. Plans Summary:

- (1) A/2-35 and C/2-35 will continue to conduct search and destroy operations, sweeping to the west.
- (2) B/2-35 will provide 2-35 Inf FSB security and conduct local patrolling. In addition, they will provide reserve/reaction force for the battalion operation.
- (3) Recon 2-35 will provide three LRRP teams to be inserted at YA 639531, (12 Oscar), YA639569, (12 Papa), and YA638575, (12 Quebec). LZ time will be 191600 Mar 67. These teams will be utilized for reconnaissance and tactical surveillance (RATS).
- (4) Security Platoon/2-35 will be moved by convoy from battalion rear to add additional security to the FSB and to allow an additional maneuver element in the AO.

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1. Enemy

a. Summary of Enemy Activity:

- (1) 191440, Co C, vic YA682597, loc possible hospital site containing blood plasma containers. (to be evacuated). 20 (2-3 man) bunkers with overhead cover, 20 (2-3 man) bunkers without overhead cover. Trail NS used 1-st 24 hours. Bunkers estimated 5 months old, 1-st used 4 months ago. Discovered 4 large CP type bunkers with overhead cover and sleeping area. Discovered 2 hooches estimated 8 months old 6 x 10. Bunkers and hooches destroyed.
- (2) 191430, Co A, vic YA679601, loc possible battalion size complex with 30-35 (5 man) bunkers with overhead cover. Overhead cover was constructed of 8" logs cut by saw. Discovered 10-12 CP bunkers (5 man size), 10-12 foxholes, 12 (5 man) hooches 6 x 10 complex approximately 45 days old and estimated last used 4-5 days ago. bunkers, foxholes, and hooches destroyed.
- (3) 191600 Co C, vic YA682597, located 12 bunkers with overhead cover approximately 15" thick. Estimated 6 months old. Several bunkers used within 1-st several days. Discovered well used trail estimated to be used by company size or larger within 1-st 48-72 hours. Trail runs 160 degrees to 340 degrees azimuth. Bunkers were destroyed.
- (4) 200535, Rcn Plat, 2-35, vic YA676535, observed 7 NVA with packs, weapons. Engaged with grenades and mortars. Sweeps conducted located footprints of 12-15 individuals. Some footprints, some sandal prints.
- (5) 200840, Co C, vic YA676603 located 1 NVA KIA. Body was buried and appears that individual had been killed by WP or nonlm. Body estimated to be 4-5 days old.
- (6) 201040, Co A, vic YA681603, loc 20 bunkers with overhead cover. Size: 3 man bunkers. Estimated 2-3 weeks old. No trail activity in area. Bunkers were destroyed.

b. Personnel and Equipment Losses:

- (1) Personnel: 1 NVA KIA (Ref par 1, 3 (5)).
- (2) Equipment: Bunkers destroyed - 123, hooches destroyed - 14.

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c. Weather and Terrain Conditions: No change.

d. Enemy Capabilities and Vulnerabilities:

- (1) Enemy remains capable of conducting ground attacks in force coordinated with mortar attacks.
- (2) Enemy can and probably does maintain surveillance of the fire base, and will be quick to notice any weakness or pattern in all security.
- (3) Enemy is capable of monitoring our radio traffic.
- (4) Enemy remains vulnerable to air and artillery should he mass for ground attack, also to counter mortar fire and ambush around the perimeter.

e. Conclusions

- (1) The presence of the enemy 50 meters from our perimeter indicates continued interest in our fire base; possibly in preparation for a squad and/or mortar attack.
- (2) Laxity in communications security is unnecessarily endangering our elements especially LRRPs and elements conducting CAs.

2. Own Situation

a. Operations Summary: 2nd Battalion, 35th Infantry Task Force continued to conduct search and destroy, ambush and blocking actions, under OPCON 1st Bde, 4th Inf Div, in AO SAM HOUSTON. C/2-9th Art and one squad from Company A, 4th Engineer Battalion remain attached to 2-35 Inf.

- (1) A/2-35 continued to conduct search and destroy operations in AO, sweeping to the west and closing with C/2-35 at 191825H March 67, vic YA676603. At 200820H, A/2-35 left their night location and continued to sweep west to vic YA663608 with negative contact.
- (2) B/2-35 continued to provide FSB security and conducted a patrol to YA690541 to check out a suspected enemy radio station. They left 191400H and returned to the FSB with negative contact at 191810 H Mar 67. At 201100H Mar 67, a TRACKER/dog team was attached to Company B in order to follow a fresh trail to the northwest. There was negative contact during the reporting period.
- (3) C/2-35 conducted search and destroy operations to the west, closing to night location YA676603 at 191645H Mar 67. At 200840H Mar 67, C/2-35 moved from their night location and swept west to vic YA665591 with negative contact.
- (4) Recon/2-35 continued to provide LRRP assets for the battalion and to provide night ambush sites.

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(a) LRRP OSCAR was inserted YA639531 at 191700H Mar 67 and moved to night location YA639532. At 201200H Mar 67, OSCAR was located YA640530.

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(b) LRRP PAPA was inserted at YA639569 at 191655H and moved to night location YA639568. At 201200H Mar 67, PAPA was located at YA639568.

(c) LRRP QUEBEC was inserted at YA638575 at 191632H and moved to night location YA635578. At 201200H Mar 67, QUEBEC was located YA636588.

(5) Security Platoon/2-35 arrived FSB at 191506H to provide additional security for the FSB.

(6) The RRU team and a seven man security force were inserted YA696560 at 201210H Mar 67.

b. Plans Summary:

(1) A/2-35 and C/2-35 will continue to conduct search and destroy operations, sweeping to the west to the north/south 66 Grid line and then begin their sweep to the south between the 66 and 67 Grid line.

(2) B/2-35 will continue to provide 2-35 Inf FSB security and will conduct local patrolling and ambushes.

(3) Recon/2-35 will continue to provide RATS teams and reinforce the FSB on call.

1. Enemy

a. Summary of Enemy Activity:

- (1) 201255H, IRRP 12 Oscar, vic YA660530, loc NS trail, old trail and no evidence of recent use.
- (2) 201445H, 2-8 Inf, vic CP9 reports a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ T vehicle (HQ 68, 2-35) struck a land mine negative casualties. Damage to vehicle; est front end of vehicle damaged. Lead tank providing security for 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ T vehicle struck land mine same vicinity.
- (3) 201530H, Co A, vic YA669585, loc 20 bunkers used recently, 15 bunkers were old 5 were new. New bunkers estimated used one day ago, discovered cooking pits still warm. All bunkers had overhead cover. Also discovered unk number shovels, fuses and canteens. Bunkers and equipment not destroyed.
- (4) 201600, vic of CP9, pilot of resupply ship reported received AW fire (unk cal). Negative casualties, neg hits on acft.
- (5) 201700H, Recon Plat 2-35, vic YA675540, rechecked trail previously reported in INTSUM No 8 (Par 3 a (8)), Trail est to have been used by platoon 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ -2 days ago. Also loc NVA hot on trail.
- (6) 202130H, Co A, Co C, vic YA664582, reported hearing movement around perimeter. Arty fired in area.
- (7) 210110H, Co A, vic YA664582 suspects movement in front of their position 400-500M N. Arty fired DEFCONS.
- (8) Ref items (6) (7) above sweeps completed 210741H with negative results.
- (9) 211115H, Co B, vic YA695533, loc unk type land mine. No evidence of being command detonated mine destroyed. Crater approximately 2' deep, 3' diameter. Mine located on shoulder of road.
- (10) 211143H, Co B, vic YA696533, loc unk type land mine. Mine destroyed in place. Appears to be same as (9) above. Mine located on shoulder of road.

b. Personnel and Equipment Losses:

- (1) Personnel: Negative.

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(2) Equipment:

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(a) US: One 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ T vehicle - damaged. One tank - damaged.

(b) Enemy: Two unknown type land mines destroyed.

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c. Weather and Terrain Conditions: Possibility of rain showers and thunder storms in area. Maximum temp 96°.

d. Enemy Capabilities and Vulnerabilities:

(1) Enemy remains capable of mining road, conducting ground, mortar attacks on the firebase.

(2) Enemy remains vulnerable to air strikes and artillery fire.

e. Conclusions:

(1) Mining incidents will continue, enemy has had impressive results at no cost to himself.

(2) Enemy is avoiding contact at present, though he is still in the area, probably in force.

2. Own Situation

a. Operations Summary: 2nd Battalion, 35th Infantry Task Force continued search and destroy operations in AO SAM HOUSTON under OPCON 1st Brigade, 4th Infantry Division.

(1) A/2-35 and C/2-35 continued to sweep to the west to the 66 grid line. They then swept to the south to mine location vicinity YA665584, closing at 1530H and 1510H respectively, with negative enemy contact.

(2) B/2-35 Infantry conducted local patrolling around the FSB and provided FSB security.

(3) Recon/2-35 Infantry continued to provide LRRP assets and provided local ambush points.

(a) LRRP Oscar extracted at 1141H and LRRP Quebec extracted at 211143H Mar 67.

(b) LRRP Pope in location YA639568. Pope has one man who is sick.

b. Plans Summary:

(1) 2-35 Infantry Task Force will continue to conduct search and destroy operations in AO SAM HOUSTON.

(a) A/2-35 and C/2-35 will continue to sweep to the south toward 2-35 Infantry FSB.

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(b) B/2-35 will continue to provide FSB security and, on call, be deployed as 2-35 Infantry reserve/reaction force.

(2) LRRP Paper will be extracted on 21 March 1967
