

			<p>SITUATION: The 2nd Bn 35th Inf continued S & D operations in 10 as part of TF ORANGE. At 0601H, the ESB remained under attack, mortar and light SA fire generally from the west. The 2-35 continued to engage with all available weapons. Enemy fire ceased about 0630H and fire was directed on possible enemy withdrawal routes. A local sweep of the area resulted in several VCS detained (see Sec 1).</p>


