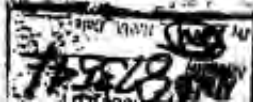

The EM was told to take this EM to check NW of his gun position. At approx. 30 meters from his gun position he was to check out AO for trails. At this time the only thing that I can think of that happened is that the two EM went in the wrong direction. They were also 100 meters from the NL.
