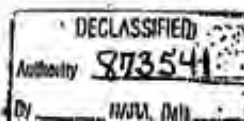

The second platoon and one element of CIDG will go from LZ 4C to proposed ambush site (968570). The first platoon will remain at this position while a few members of the CIDG, dressed as Montagnards, enter the village to observe events inside village. <sup>(937350)</sup> The following

day (the 13<sup>th</sup>) the ~~first~~<sup>second</sup> platoon will enter the village and pick up the disguised CIDG as suspects and see what information they could obtain.

Company C: The second and third platoons will head south to village (957434) together. After a brief search of village the two platoons will split-up. The second platoon will leave the village heading in a south-westerly direction and patrol to the east, turn to the north after about 3,000 meters and head north and then return to the village from the east. The third platoon will leave the village heading west, swing up to a north-westerly direction for about 1,000 meters then continue west. They will then head south and return to the village from a north westerly direction. Both platoons will return to LZ 9E.

The Recon platoon will go on a three day operation in area of 9648 and 9748

from previous night's ambush site. They  
will set up two observation posts, at two  
hedge sights (0970472, and 0965495).

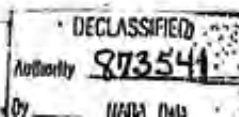
